The unit standards in **bold** have been revised to correct grammatical errors and provide more complete reference details.

Responsibility for the levels 5, 6 and 7 unit standards referred to above, which were registered in February 1998, and for the qualification, which was registered in February 1999, has been transferred from NZQA – National Qualifications Services to InfraTrain New Zealand Ltd. The rationale for the transfer was that these unit standards aligned with the upper level *Technology* unit standards for which InfraTrain New Zealand Ltd was already responsible.

The review of the unit standards is planned to take place during 2005.

Unit Standards
