At the request of the New Zealand Painting Contractors Association of Employers Industry Training Organisation (Painting ITO), the Qualifications Authority has changed the classification of the unit standards referred to above that were re-registered in January 2003 following their review.

Date new versions published**January 2004****Rationale for the change**

In consultation with the painting and decorating industry, the Painting ITO undertook a review of the National Certificate in Painting and Decorating [Ref:0021]. The industry wishes to focus the reviewed qualification on painting with optional strands so a new unit standard domain, *Painting*, has been established to support this development.

The following unit standards have been affected by the change. They have been amended to show the new domain, *Painting*, and published as new versions.
