

- Unit standard 13246 was replaced by unit standard 21809.
- *Cargo and Freight* unit standards 13236, 13238, 13239, 13241, 13244, and 13245 were designated as expiring as no longer relevant to freight forwarding.
- *Commercial Shipping Practice* unit standards 13253, 13255, 13259, 13260, and 13261 were designated as expiring as no longer relevant to international freight forwarding.
- *Transport Law* unit standards 13267, 13268, and 13269 were designated as expiring as no longer relevant to international freight forwarding.
- *Transport Law* unit standards 13262 and 13265 were designated as expiring, as these functions are no longer carried out by the freight forwarding industry.
- Eight new unit standards were established to cover the remaining attributes, skills and knowledge required in the international freight forwarding industry.

Unit standards categorised as category C and D expire at the end of December 2005.
