This unit standard had passed its expiry date and has had its period of registration extended to maintain its currency until it is reviewed.

Resulting from the research described in Section 1 of this report it was recommended that review of the National Diploma in Stevedoring and Ports Industry (Pilot Operations) [Ref: 0520] (and consequentially the above unit standard) 'be held in abeyance until the full implications of the draft New Zealand Ports and Harbours Safety Code promulgated by the Maritime Safety Authority are fully known'.

Therefore, although this unit standard was not included in the review covered in Section 1 of this report, it is confirmed that it will be fully reviewed once the full implications of the draft New Zealand Ports and Harbours Safety Code are known. Changes were made to special notes in order to ensure currency with external requirements and to match the style of special notes in the reviewed unit standards.
