

Impact on existing provider accreditations

Providers with accreditation for the domain Chainsaw Operating will have their accreditation extended to the domain Non Commercial Forestry Skills and to the unit standard 6916 in its new classification of Forest Landing Operations. FITEC's Quality Manager is working with providers to ensure that they gain the relevant accreditation for the commercial forestry and non commercial forestry chainsaw unit standards.
