The Forest Industries Training and Education Council (FITEC) has rolled over the unit standards listed above to maintain their currency until they are reviewed, and has revised them.

Reason for the revision

This revision and rollover was undertaken to enable candidates to access the standards as part of a training programme. Although these unit standards were not currently listed in any FITEC qualification, it was intended that these unit standards be included in the new qualification structure that was currently being created.

They were not included in the original review process as their anticipated expiry date was December 2008 and it was considered more important and urgent to review unit standards with earlier anticipated expiry dates.

Main changes resulting from the revision

- The unit standards were reclassified in the domain Forest Harvesting Operations.
- The credits for unit standards 19762 and 19763 increased.
- The special notes for each unit standard were standardised to fit in with FITEC's current format for special notes.
- Some minor changes were made to the content of unit standards 19762 and 19763, and their titles were amended.
