Summary of review and consultation process

This standard was reviewed at the request of industry stakeholders, and was carried out through consultation.

Main changes resulting from the review

The main change addresses the amendment of requirements to permit Registered Electricians, Registered Electrical Inspectors, or Registered Electrical Engineers holding an Electrical Workers Registration Board (EWRB) Qualified Engineer Identification Card to gain exemption from requirements of standard 20592.
