The Building and Construction Industry Training Organisation has completed the review of the qualification and unit standards listed above.

**Date report published****September 2008****Summary of review and consultation process**

It was indicated by industry representatives that the qualification and unit standards above were no longer required by industry. Upon consultation with accredited providers, it was confirmed that they were not being sufficiently utilised to warrant their continued registration, and there were no objections to the expiry of the qualification and unit standards as long as sufficient time was allowed for existing candidates to complete them. The Carpentry National Advisory group endorsed this decision at a meeting on 10 April 2008.

**Main changes resulting from the qualification review**

The National Certificate in Carpentry (Advanced) [Ref: 0363] has been designated as expiring.
