**Revision of *Learning State* AMAP**

Learning State has revised the Accreditation and Moderation Action Plan (AMAP) above.

**Date new version published**

**April 2010**

The next AMAP review is planned to take place during 2013.

**Reason for the revision**

The AMAP was revised to make the experience requirements for the appointment of teaching and/or assessing staff less restrictive (Criterion 3 of industry or sector-specific requirements for accreditation).

**Compliance with new requirements**

Accreditation requirements will apply with effect from April 2010.

Accredited organisations will be expected to be able to demonstrate compliance with AMAP requirements from October 2010 onwards.

**Main changes resulting from the revision**

**ACCREDITATION INFORMATION (AI)**

Industry or sector-specific requirements for accreditation

- Criterion 3 – requirement for teaching and/or assessing staff to have ‘substantial industry and teaching experience’ has been replaced with a requirement for ‘substantial experience’.
