

**Field                    Planning and Construction****Review of *Joinery* qualification****National Certificate in Joinery (Aluminium Fabrication) [Ref: 0389]**

The Joinery Industry Training Organisation has completed the review of the qualification above.

**Date new version published****November 2010****Summary of review and consultation process**

To clear up a historical anomaly, Competenz agreed to transfer responsibility for the *Architectural Aluminium Joinery* domain to the Joinery Industry Training Organisation as it is more appropriate to their area of standard setting responsibility.

As part of the transfer of responsibility it was noted that the qualification above was already registered by the Joinery Industry Training Organisation but had not had support from industry. The sector had not considered the qualification fit for purpose and, instead, had been using the qualifications developed by Competenz in the architectural aluminium joinery area, meaning the qualification had never been awarded. For this reason this qualification has been designated expiring without replacement.

**Main changes resulting from the review**

The qualification has been designated expiring and will not be replaced.

	The new version of the qualification recognises a similar skill set to that recognised by the previous version

<b>Category C</b> A new (replacement) qualification is published with new NQF ID	Significant changes are made to the qualification in terms of components, structure, type or level
	The SSB views people with the replacement qualification as being significantly different in terms of competence from those with the replaced qualification
