**Summary**

The ElectroTechnology Industry Training Organisation in conjunction with the Electrical Industry and the Electrical Workers Registration Board has reviewed the unit standards and developed the new unit standards to meet the requirements of the Electricity (Safety) Regulations 2010.

- The review process amended standards 1702 and 21766 to meet the requirements of the Electricity (Safety) Regulations 2010.
- Five new standards were developed.
