The Aviation, Tourism and Travel Training Organisation (ATTTO) has completed the revision of the unit standard above.

**Summary**

Assessment against the unit standard and subsequent moderation revealed repetition in the evidence requirements leading to two of them being removed. The opportunity was also taken to make some minor editorial changes.

**Main changes**

- Evidence requirements 1.6 and 1.7 were removed.
- The title was amended to correct an error.
