Summary of the review and consultation process

During 2013, as part of the Targeted Review of Qualifications (TRoQ) a mandatory sector review of the health, disability and social services sectors' qualifications occurred. The review process included an analysis of the sectors' learning needs and extensive consultation with stakeholders working in and with the sector to provide health, disability and social services to individuals, family/whānau and the wider community.

The sector confirmed the ongoing need for a qualification that would recognise graduate capabilities and provide an education and employment pathway for trainees.
