Summary

As a result of the Targeted Review of Qualifications process, Primary Industry Training Organisation (Primary ITO) has reviewed a number of unit standards to better reflect the requirements of the outcomes listed in the new qualifications. During this process, it was identified that a number of standards were no longer fit for purpose and replacement unit standards were developed.

Main changes

- New unit standards have been developed to meet the industry and qualification graduate profile outcomes.
- New unit standards replace existing unit standards in order to better reflect the unit standard outcomes and credits adjusted to reflect learning and assessment.
- Outcomes, evidence requirements, ranges and/or explanatory notes were developed to ensure consistency of delivery and assessment.

Category C and D unit standards will expire at the end of December 2020
