### June 2015

The next qualification review, of the New Zealand qualifications, is planned to take place by 31 December 2020.

### Summary of review and consultation process

During 2012, a mandatory sector review of qualifications in the Justice and Law (Compliance) sector occurred. The review encompassed broad consultation with the sector and training provider stakeholders to ensure that the new qualifications meet current and future needs. The review resulted in the recommendation that the national qualifications listed above should be replaced by New Zealand qualifications. The replacement New Zealand qualifications have now been listed, and the national qualifications will therefore be phased out.

From that date, no results can be reported against the qualifications.

People currently working towards one of the replaced qualifications may either complete the requirements by 31 December 2020 or transfer their results to the replacement qualification.
