**Summary of review and consultation process**

- Alignment of unit standards undertaken in the Programme of Industry Training (PIT) process for this qualification has resulted in one core Graduate Profile Outcome (GPO) being incorporated into each individual strand with a resulting change to credit allocation for a number of the GPOs.

**Version 1 of the qualification will expire at the end of December 2017.**
