**Summary**

Following the review of qualifications in the Scaffolding sector, consultation with subject matter experts was held to review and revise unit standards that may be used in unit standard based programmes leading to award of the New Zealand Scaffolding qualifications. As the overarching credit value of the qualifications were reduced to better reflect the journey of learning, practice and assessment, the unit standards also reflect this change.

**Main changes**

- The planned review date of all standards was rolled over to December 2020.
- Credit values for standards 19622, 20858, 23223-23227, 23715, 23718-23721, and 26606 were reduced to ensure the standards work well as a suite of standards, including acknowledging the learning and assessment involved in acquiring the prerequisite standards.
- Titles for standards 20858, 23223, and 23224 were amended to consistently use the phrasing tube and coupler.
- The title of standard 23226 was amended to refer to proprietary falsework.
- New unit standard 30628 was developed to meet the needs of the scaffolding sector relating to leadership and communication on a scaffolding worksite.
