Review of the *Painting and Decorating* qualification:

National Certificate in Painting and Decorating (Level 4) [Ref: 1696]

The Building and Construction Industry Training Organisation has completed the review of the qualification listed above.

Date new versions published

January 2017

The next qualification review is planned to take place during 2021.

Reason for the review

This review took place as part of stakeholder consultation for the mandatory Targeted Review of Qualifications (TRoQ) initiated in 2013.

Industry identified the need for a qualification to reflect that of a qualified Painter and Decorator.

Main changes resulting from the review

- **National Certificate in Painting and Decorating (Level 4) [Ref: 1696]**
Replaced with
New Zealand Certificate in Painting and Decorating (Level 4) with strands in Specialised Spraying, Wallcoverings, and Specialised Coatings [Ref: 3568].
- The reviewed qualification is 204 credits. The credit range in the replacement qualification is 170 - 270.

Key to the Qualification Review Categories

Category A The qualification is published as a new version with the same NQF ID	Changes are made to SSB name, contact details or purpose statement
	No change is made to title, rules or components of the qualification
	No transition arrangements are required
Category B The qualification is published as a new version with the same NQF ID	Changes are made to title, rules or components
	The new version of the qualification recognises a similar skill set to that recognised by the previous version
	The SSB is confident that people awarded the new or previous version are comparable in terms of competence
	Transition arrangements are required if candidates must gain additional/different credits for the new version
Category C A new (replacement) qualification is published with new NZQF ID	Significant changes are made to the qualification in terms of components, structure, type or level
	The SSB views people with the replacement qualification as being significantly different in terms of competence from those with the replaced qualification
	Transition arrangements are required
	Transition may be limited to phase-out dates
Category D Qualification will expire. There is no replacement qualification	Qualification is no longer required by industry
