Summary of review and consultation process

Between 2012 and 2016, a mandatory sector review of qualifications in the Recreation, Sport and Fitness sector occurred. The review encompassed broad consultation with industry and training provider stakeholders to ensure that the new qualifications meet current and future needs.

The review resulted in the recommendation that the national qualifications listed above should be replaced by New Zealand qualifications. The replacement New Zealand qualifications have now been listed, and the national qualifications will, therefore, be phased out.

Main changes resulting from the review

National Diploma in Outdoor Recreation (Instruction) (Level 5) [Ref: 1191]

Please note that the elective section of this qualification includes several expired standards and unit standard 14473 expiring in 31 December 2019. To meet the requirements of the elective section candidates are able to select standards from the Te Ao Tūroa domain, any domain within the Outdoor Recreation subfield and/or unit standards 19433 and 19434. Candidates wishing to complete the requirements of this qualification via unit standard 14473 must do so before 31 December 2019.
