MITO New Zealand Incorporated (MITO) has completed the review of the unit standards listed above.

**Summary**

As a result of work carried out by MITO on the Targeted Review of Qualifications, unit standards from the *Stevedoring and Ports Industry* subfield have been reviewed. These unit standards were reviewed using input from industry and provider representatives. The next full review will take place in five years time.

**Main changes**

- Changes were made to the explanatory notes, evidence requirements and range statements of the unit standards for clarity and to ensure alignment with relevant industry standards and regulations.
- Unit standard 28899 was set to expiring and is being replaced by unit standard 30223.
- Unit standard 28902 had changes made to the title, outcomes and evidence requirements to make the unit standards theory-based only.
- Unit standard 28904 was increased by 10 credits to better reflect the time required to complete the unit standard.
- Unit standard 30222 was created as industry identified a gap in the required knowledge for the industry.

**The Category C unit standard will expire at the end of December 2022**

**The last date for assessment of superseded versions of Category B unit standards is December 2019**
