The next qualification review is planned to take place during September 2023.

Summary of review and consultation process

Feedback from industry triggered an early review of these qualifications.

MITO commenced an early review of these qualifications with industry stakeholders to ensure they accurately reflected the needs of the commercial road transport industry. Recommendations were made by industry stakeholders to ensure these qualifications accurately reflect the skills and knowledge required of graduates.

Conditions on graduate profile outcomes which placed unnecessary restrictions on learners' ability to complete the qualifications were removed.

The New Zealand Certificate in Commercial Road Transport (Level 2) [Ref: 3088] was increased to a Level 3 qualification to align with NZQA level descriptors.
