#### Summary

These standards had been designated expiring, however, they have now been reinstated to enable delivery of programmes leading towards the New Zealand Certificate in Drilling (Level 3) [Ref: 2621] and the New Zealand Certificate in Drilling (Level 4) [Ref: 2622].

#### Main changes

- Unit standards 22464, 28314 and 28333 were reinstated.
- Guidance information was updated to include current legislation, references to the Australian units of competency and Memorandum of Understanding arrangements.

#### Impact on Consent and Moderation Requirements (CMR)

Unit standards were shifted from CMR 0114 to CMR 0014.
