The Primary Industry Training Organisation has completed the reinstatement and reclassification of the unit standards listed above. Unit standards that have been reclassified are listed in **bold** above.

**Date new versions published****April 2019****Summary**

The reinstatement (as outlined below), was required to align with the expiry date of the National Certificate in Leather Manufacture Technology (Introductory) (Level 3) available with Merit [Ref: 0419], the National Certificate in Leather Manufacture Technology (Advanced) (Level 4) available with Merit [Ref: 0420].

**Main changes**

- Unit standards were reinstated with an expiring status, and the last date for assessment was set to 31 December 2020.
- Unit standards 8388 and 8390 were reclassified from subfield *Leather Manufacturing*, domain *Leather Manufacture* to subfield *Fellmongery and Leather Processing*, domain *Leather Processing Knowledge* so the standards could be registered in a domain with 'current' status.
