Summary

MQS has revised the unit standard to extend the review date to December 2020 to ensure the review of the unit standards follows the review of the Te Hiringa o te Taiao (Kaupae 4) [Ref: 2346] and Rumakihia te Taiao (Kaupae 6) [Ref: 2347] qualifications. The qualifications' review is scheduled for December 2019.

Changes have been made only where necessary to ensure each standard is current, and on the latest standard template.

Main changes

- The standards were rolled over to extend their planned review dates from December 2019 to December 2020.
- All unit standards were revised to update terminology, make minor amendments to the guidance information, and correct spelling errors (particularly macrons on Māori words).
