### Summary of review and consultation process

The review of Pork Production qualifications commenced in August 2019.

Expressions of interest were sought in August 2019 from industry stakeholders who had an interest in the sector that represented pork production.

An External Working Group (EWG) made up of key industry stakeholders was formed to contribute to the review of qualifications. EWG members had the responsibility of contributing their expertise to qualification content and recommend updates as well as liaising with their networks over the duration of the review.

The qualifications were updated based on feedback with the wider stakeholder consultation process carried out by External Working Group members.

Agreement of qualification content was reached; stakeholders went back to their networks for affirmation attestations were gained from working group members and key stakeholders in April 2020.

The EWG signed off on the final versions in April 2020.

#### Main changes resulting from the review

Changes are as follows:

New Zealand Certificate in Pork Production (Stockperson) (Level 3) with optional strand in Reproduction [Ref: 2525-1]

Change report for review of New Zealand qualifications v.2

- Graduate profile outcomes were updated for clarity and currency.
- Credit values were adjusted and amended.
- Reproduction optional strand replaced by Farrowing Care optional strand.
- Legislation and guidelines were updated.

New Zealand Certificate in Pork Production (Section Management) (Level 4) [Ref: 2524-1] and New Zealand Certificate in Pork Production (Advanced Husbandry) (Level 4) [Ref: 2526-1]

- These qualifications were considered not fit for purpose and will be discontinued.
- A fit for purpose replacement qualification was developed. This includes an optional strand in Pig Farm Production Planning.
