NZQA Maori Qualifications Services (MQS) has completed the review of the unit standards listed above.

**Summary**

As a result of the planned standards review cycle, MQS along with the Whakaruruhau, reviewed the *Te Aho Wahine* unit standards to ensure they remain fit for purpose and meet the aspirations and needs of ākonga, as well as whānau, hapū and iwi.

**Main changes**

The main changes that were made to the standards include the following:

- Minor wording changes have been made to some outcomes and performance criteria for relevancy, consistency and to provide clarity for ākonga and kaiako.
- Definitions in the guide information section have been updated.
- Grammatical errors have been corrected.
- Changes were made to levels and credits for unit standards 10701, 10708 and 10710 to better reflect the complexity of work required, and time needed to complete their requirements.
- Unit standards 10702, 10703, 10704, 10705, 10706 and 10709 have been expired due to no usage.
