Summary

The Primary ITO reviewed unit standards within the *Agricultural Vehicles and Machinery* domain to better reflect current industry requirements.

Consultation was carried out in July 2021 with consent to assess holders and stakeholders by email requesting feedback and amendments to ensure the unit standards reflected current industry requirements. Feedback was incorporated where valid.

Main changes

- Unit standards were updated to meet current template requirements.
- Guidance information and performance criteria were amended to ensure unit standard content remained fit for purpose.
- Unit standard 19064 was expired due to little or no usage in the last two years, and no anticipated usage in the future.

The last date for assessment of superseded versions of Category B unit standards is December 2023

Category D unit standard will expire at the end of December 2022
