Rollover and revision of *Building, Construction, and Allied Trades Skills* unit standards

Waihanga Ara Rau Construction and Infrastructure Workforce Development Council has completed the rollover of the unit standards listed above. The unit standards in *italics* have been rolled over and revised.

Summary

The qualification these unit standards lead to, New Zealand Certificate in Building, Construction, and Allied Trades Skills (Level 3) [Ref: 3845], along with the two other Building, Construction, and Allied Trades Skills qualifications at Levels 1 and 2 [Ref: 3843 and 3844], are due for review in July 2023. Waihanga Ara Rau plan to complete a full review of the unit standards following the review of the qualifications. December 2024 as a new review date would allow for the development of skill standards, and all standards across the suite of three qualifications would be consistent.

Consultation was undertaken between July–August 2022 with 300 providers, including both secondary and tertiary providers. Consultation included:

- website survey
- workshops to gather feedback
- online hui to confirm the review outcome for each unit standard.

Main changes

- The planned review date of eight unit standards listed above was rolled over from 31 December 2021 to 31 December 2024.
- Unit standard 29677 and unit standard 29678 were revised to remove barriers to learner completion. Unit standard 29677 performance criteria has been revised to align more precisely to the outcome, and unit standard 29678 guidance information makes clearer the meaning of materials.
