- Recommended texts were amended for unit standards 19585, 19586, 19587, 20676 and 20677.
- Minor changes to performance criteria and range statements were made for unit standards 19585 and 19586.
- Planned next review date extended to 31 December 2025 from 31 December 2023.
- Standard setting body contact details were amended from ServiceIQ to Ringa Hora Services Workforce Council.
