Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

1.2 The roles of OSH personnel and compliance officers are compared in clear and concise language.

Range role in notification of failure to comply; enforcement; planning to avoid harm – structures, work sites, work practices.

Outcome 2

Act to ensure client compliance with the HSE Act 1992 in a compliance context.

Performance criteria

2.1 Procedures are followed to ensure that the client identifies hazards and potential hazards to contractors, employees, and the public in planning documents.

Range proposed work procedures, use of equipment, structures, and work sites.

2.2 Client is advised in clear and concise written language of remedial action that will enable compliance with the HSE Act 1992.

Range may include but is not limited to remedial action regarding – work procedures, use of equipment, structures, work sites.
