Service information refers to information such as technical information for a vehicle, machine, or product detailing operation; installation and servicing procedures; manufacturer instructions; technical terms and descriptions; and detailed illustrations.
- 4 Range
includes fitting interior components to any one of the following types of vehicle – passenger service vehicle, coach, motor home, ambulance, caravan, special purpose vehicle;
may include – climate and temperature controls, racks, lockers, seats, furniture, lighting, hygiene equipment, floor coverings, mouldings, trims.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare to fit out the interior of a passenger service or motor home type vehicle.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Customer requirements are verified and checked.
- 1.2 Materials used to fit out the vehicle interior are identified and procured.

Outcome 2

Fit out the interior of a passenger service or motor home type vehicle.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Low voltage electrical wiring and components are fitted to the vehicle.
- 2.2 Any 230 voltage electrical wiring is arranged to be completed and certified.
- 2.3 Insulation is fitted to the vehicle.
- 2.4 Interior linings and floor covering are fitted to the vehicle.
- 2.5 Interior components are fitted to the vehicle.
- 2.6 Vehicle is checked and all parts operate.
- 2.7 Vehicle interior is groomed and prepared for the customer.
