### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Identify spars.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Types of spars are identified in accordance with boat type and designer specifications.
- Range spar shapes and types, materials used in spars and rigging.
- 1.2 Configuration of spars on the different types of boat are identified in accordance with boat designer specifications.

#### Outcome 2

Identify running and standing rigging.

#### Performance criteria

- 2.1 The functions and locations of the forestays, backstays, baby stays, and shrouds are identified in accordance with boat designer specifications.

- 2.2 The functions and locations of halyards and topping lifts are identified in accordance with boat designer specifications.
- 2.3 Types of wire and rope attachments are identified in accordance with boat designer specifications.
- Range talurits, splices, thimbles, swage ends.
- 2.4 Functions and locations of sail adjustment controls are identified in accordance with boat designer specifications.
