Mark out job panels.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Layout of panels is determined in accordance with design specifications and workplace policies and procedures.
- 3.2 Panels are marked out on the selected material in accordance with design specifications and workplace policies and procedures
- 3.3 Panel alignment marks are applied in accordance with design specifications and workplace policies and procedures.
- 3.4 Panels are marked for product and assembly identification in accordance with workplace policies and procedures.

Outcome 4

Cut out panels.

Performance criteria

- 4.1 Tool for cutting out is prepared in accordance with workplace policies and procedures.
- 4.2 Panels are cut out to the marked lines in accordance with job specifications and workplace policies and procedures.
