- 2.2 The viral life cycles are described in terms of the differences and similarities of their effect on bacterial cells.

### Outcome 3

Describe the impact of a plant and an animal virus on their hosts.

#### Performance criteria

- 3.1 The cytopathic effects of the selected virus are described in terms of the host cell's structure and biochemistry.
- 3.2 Specific host/virus interactions are described in terms of their impact on the host.
