Range set up, guarding, cleanliness of machinery and work area, manufacturer's instructions.

- 1.2 Care and maintenance of woodworking machinery is described in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.

Range blades, knives, cutting edges, adjustment, cleaning, power source, guarding.

1.3 Use of woodworking machinery is described in terms of health and safety requirements.

Range identification of hazards and controls, prevention of injury to users and others, damage to materials and machinery.
