Performance criteria

1.1 Identify and describe Building Consent Authority requirements for demolition work.

Range requirements for – traffic control, noise, dust, working hours, waste disposal, disposal of hazardous materials.

1.2 Describe the factors for consideration when preparing to demolish a structure.

Range factors include – condition, position and support of existing buildings and services, notifiable work, hazardous materials, support and protection for the remaining structure.

Demonstrate knowledge of health and safety for demolition work.

Range labour, identification of hazards and controls, plant;
 plant includes – any machinery, vehicle, vessel, aircraft, equipment (including personal protective equipment), appliance, container, implement, or tool; any component of any of those things; anything fitted or connected to any of those things;
 personal protective equipment includes – anything used or worn by a person (including clothing) to minimise risks to the person's health and safety; air supplied respiratory equipment.
