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### Guidance Information

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Complete site identification and establish facilities.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Land is identified in terms of site plan and boundary markers.
- 1.2 Construction area and datum points are confirmed in terms of site plan requirements.

- 1.3 The set up of temporary site facilities is completed in accordance with job requirements, site limitations, and the employer’s safety procedures.

**Outcome 2**

Comply with Territorial Authority and/or Building Consent Authority requirements on site.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Issue of building consent is confirmed prior to commencement of work.
- 2.2 Territorial Authority and/or Building Consent Authority requirements are complied with, as specified in the building consent.
