Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of the advantages and disadvantages of freighting goods in different transport industry sectors.

Performance criteria

1.1 The characteristics of each sector are identified and compared.

Range size, speed, network, cost, reliability, flexibility, modal capacity, ability to reach destination, gross tonnage per annum, cargo handling ability and facilities, inter-modal connectivity.

1.2 The functions of the types of businesses operating in transport industry sectors are described.

Range freight forwarding, customs broking, transport operators, transport agents.

1.3 The advantages and disadvantages of freighting goods using each sector are explained.

Range evidence of one advantage and one disadvantage for each sector is required.

- 1.4 The selection of an industry transport sector for the freighting of a given cargo is justified.

Range evidence of three cargoes is required.
