*Organisational requirements* include any legal requirements, standards, codes of practice, company and/or site procedures, industry best practice, and manufacturers' instructions. These must be available to candidates, providers, and assessors.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Clean a coach.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Exterior of coach is cleaned in accordance with organisational requirements.  
  
Range may include – vehicle positioned in designated washing area, windows and doors closed, engine stopped.
- 1.2 Where applicable to the vehicle, toilet contents are emptied in accordance with the provisions of the Resource Management Act and local by-laws.

1.3 Where applicable to the vehicle, washroom is cleaned in accordance with organisational requirements.

Range may include – towels replaced; bowls and mirrors cleaned; floor and walls washed; rubbish disposed of in accordance with Resource Management Act, local by-laws, and site rules.

1.4 Passenger compartment is cleaned in accordance with organisational requirements.

Range may include – left luggage collected; rubbish receptacles emptied and contents disposed of in accordance with Resource Management Act, local by-laws, and site rules; seats and floor vacuumed; surfaces wiped clean and polished; windows cleaned.

## Outcome 2

Replenish consumables.

### Performance criteria

2.1 Remaining stock is assessed in accordance with organisational requirements.

Range quantity, suitability.

2.2 Requirements are calculated and stock is replenished in accordance with anticipated distance to be travelled, rest stops, availability of replacements, and water quality en-route.
