The *naming system* refers to the approved name, approved foreign name, or the Māori name in New Zealand;

- 1.2 Describe information sources for locating the scientific name for seafood species from a common name.

Range evidence from two sources is required.

- 1.3 Identify the name of seafood species using different naming systems.

Range evidence of two naming systems for three species is required.

Outcome 2

Identify the features of seafood species in the New Zealand seafood industry.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Identify the key features of seafood species.

Range evidence of three species is required.
