# Outcomes and performance criteria

### Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of the Cook Islands' natural environment in relation to tourism and of interest to visitors.

### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Geographical features are identified suitable for inclusion in a promotion of the Cook Islands as a tourism destination.
  - Range examples of geographical features are mountains, valleys, waterfalls, lagoons; evidence is required for a minimum of three geographical features for a minimum of two islands, one of which must be the learner's own island.
- 1.2 Flora local to the area are identified and described in terms of their use.

Range use may include – cultural, medicinal, environmental, economic.

1.3 An aspect of the Cook Islands natural environment is described in terms of opportunities to promote a special interest tour.

Range one of – plants, birds, sea life, geology.

## Outcome 2

Demonstrate knowledge of factors that impact on the natural environment in the Cook Islands as a result of, and in relation to tourism.

Range examples of factors are – development projects, industry, visitor numbers and activities, rubbish disposal methods, waste disposal methods; evidence is required for a minimum of two factors.

### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Factors are identified and described in terms of the impacts on geographical features.
- 2.2 Factors are identified and described in terms of the impacts on the habitat of flora and fauna in the area.
