Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Confirm job and specifications and select equipment.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Job is confirmed to be consistent with job sheet in accordance with workplace procedures.

Range	includes but is not limited to – client name, location, access, area, environment.
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- 1.2 Job specifications are confirmed to be consistent with client’s requirements and job sheet.
- 1.3 Material supplied is checked for its consistency with the material specifications.

1.4 Equipment is selected in accordance with the job specifications.

Range equipment includes but is not limited to – hand tools, staples, heat seaming equipment, trimmers, adhesive applicators, vacuum cleaner.

Outcome 2

Carry out installation of soft coverings on walls.

Performance criteria

2.1 Fastening systems, underlayments, adhesives, seam bonds and seals are applied in accordance with manufacturers' specifications.

2.2 Soft coverings are installed in accordance with manufacturers' specifications.

2.3 Materials are rolled in accordance with manufacturers' specifications.

Outcome 3

Carry out finishing procedures.

Performance criteria

3.1 Finishing accessories are installed in accordance with manufacturers' specifications.

3.2 Maintenance instructions and warranty provisions are provided to client in accordance with workplace procedures.

3.3 Equipment is cleared to a ready-to-use stage in accordance with workplace procedures.

3.4 Site is left in a secure, safe, and tidy condition in accordance with workplace procedures.

Outcome 4

Maintain a safe working environment.

Performance criteria

4.1 Work practices are carried out without injury to people or damage to equipment, building, or plant, in accordance with workplace procedures.

4.2 Personal protective equipment for the task at hand is selected and worn in accordance with manufacturers' specifications.

Range includes but is not limited to – ear muffs, safety glasses, gloves, mask, knee pads.

- 4.3 Safety notices are distributed, and signs bearing notification of work are erected in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 4.4 Work area is kept clear of debris and unnecessary equipment in accordance with workplace procedures.

Outcome 5

Complete job records.

Performance criteria

- 5.1 Job sheets are completed in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 5.2 Records are stored in accordance with workplace procedures.
