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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of the heritage of beer.

- 1.3 The evolution of the brewing process and development of the brewing craft is explained.
- 1.4 The social, economic and lifestyle impacts of beer production and consumption are explained.

**Outcome 2**

Demonstrate knowledge of beer styles and flavours.

Range beer styles include but are not limited to – ales, lagers.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Characteristics of New Zealand and international beer are explained in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.
- 2.2 Flavour problems with beer are explained in accordance with manufacturer's specifications.
- 2.3 The terminology used in tasting beer is explained in terms of manufacturer's specifications.
- 2.4 The appearance, aroma, palate, mouth feel, finish, flavour sensations, and fidelity to style of beer is analysed, using appropriate tasting terminology and flavour descriptors.
