Purpose	<p>This unit standard is intended for the operators, including drivers, dispatchers, and supervisors, of goods, passenger, and vehicle recovery vehicles which use other than scheduled or stipulated routes.</p> <p>People credited with this unit standard are able to: establish destination and possible routes; select a route; and record route details.</p>

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Guidance Information

Definition

Organisational requirements include any legal requirements, standards, codes of practice, organisational and/or site policies and procedures, industry best practice, and manufacturers' instructions. These must be available to candidates, providers, and assessors.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Establish destination and possible routes.

Performance criteria

1.1 Destination is established to be consistent with company and/or client instructions.

1.2 Possible routes are identified and are consistent with available information.

Range available information may include but is not limited to – major roads, restrictions to vehicle types, traffic lights, major intersections, heavy vehicle by-passes, road conditions, motorway on and off ramps, one-way streets, rail crossings, overpasses, underpasses.

Outcome 2

Select a route.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Route is selected to make cost-effective use of the vehicle for the conditions.
Range conditions include but are not limited to – distance, load, traffic pattern and density, road standard, weather, time of day, season.
- 2.2 Route is selected to ensure efficient operation of the vehicle.
- 2.3 Route is selected for suitability with the load being carried, and availability of rest stops en route where necessary.

Outcome 3

Record route details.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Route details are recorded in accordance with organisational requirements.
