- 3.2 Reassemble the machine, ready for operation.

#### **Outcome 4**

Complete trip documentation for a factory trawler mincing/bone separating machine.

Range may include but is not limited to – end of trip reports, machine log books, work lists, stores list, spare parts orders.

4.1 Complete trip documentation and confirm consistency with the trip, the current status of the machine, and it's on board support system.
