Outcome 1

Identify the components of the digestive tract and describe the process of digestion in poultry.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Identify the components of the digestive tract and describe their roles in the movement of food through the digestive tract.
- 1.2 Identify the organs associated with the production of enzymes and chemicals involved in digestion in terms of their location along the digestive tract.
- 1.3 Describe digestion in terms of the roles of enzymes and chemicals.

Outcome 2

Describe major feed nutrients, and the nutrient requirements of poultry.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Describe the major feed nutrients and their components in terms of their utilisation by poultry.
 - Range nutrients may include but are not limited to water, carbohydrates, sugars, fats, oils, proteins, amino acids, minerals, vitamins; evidence of at least five is required.
- 2.2 Describe the nutrient requirements of poultry according to class.
 - Range breeding poultry, brooding poultry, rearing poultry, laying poultry.

Outcome 3

Identify feed ingredients used in poultry diets and describe feed digestibility.

Performance criteria

3.1 Identify the major feed ingredients used in poultry diets in terms of their contribution to poultry nutrient requirements.

Range evidence of at least five feed ingredients is required.

3.2 Describe feed digestibility in terms of its importance to poultry nutrition.

Outcome 4

Identify and describe feeding systems and methods for poultry.

Performance criteria

4.1 Identify and describe feeding methods for poultry in relation to class of stock, sex of stock, stage of production, and in house policy and procedures.

Range evidence of at least three feeding methods is required.
