- 1.2 Vehicle is made ready for chain fitting and removal.
 - Range parking of vehicle, use of park brake and gears, hazard lights, signage, points person, check on the serviceability of chains.
- 1.3 Tyre chains are selected to match tyre manufacturer's fitting specifications.
- 1.4 Tyre chains are fitted to the drive wheels and tensioned in accordance with chain manufacturer's specifications and safety practices.

1.5 Tyre chains are removed in accordance with safety practices and without damage to tyre, vehicle or chain.
