- 1 Definition

*Workplace policies and procedures* refers to the documented procedures and policies providing guidelines of the tasks and activities carried out in the workplace.

- 2 All work practices must meet recognised codes of practice and workplace policies and procedures (where these exceed code) for personal, product, and workplace health and safety, and must meet the obligations required under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and Health and Safety in Employment Regulations 1995, and any subsequent amendments.

Range evidence of two different methods is required.
- 2.2 Timber is joined in accordance with job specifications.
- 2.3 Finished joins are checked and remedial action is taken if required to ensure job specifications are met.
