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## Guidance Information

### Definitions

*Marine or composite project* refers to a project carried out in a marine or composite workplace, and includes a defined set of activities, processes, or multi-step tasks that should be completed over a set period of time, such as installation of pipework in a boat, a boat construction project, production of a cored laminate product, or bisphenol resin product.

*Project team* refers to a group of individuals responsible for carrying out the plan in relation to the project.

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## Outcomes and performance criteria

### Outcome 1

Contribute to a project team in a marine or composite workplace.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 The process for consulting in a project team is identified in terms of methods.
- 1.2 Factors that could affect working relationships in the project team are identified in terms of potential conflict situations.  
  
Range evidence of four factors is required.
- 1.3 Working relationships with members in the project team are supported in terms of respectful communication with others.

### Outcome 2

Describe project improvements in a marine or composite workplace.

**Performance criteria**

2.1 Areas for project improvement are described.

Range areas for project improvement may include but are not limited to – revised process, activity, or task.

2.2 The process for project improvement is communicated to the team in terms of content and method.
