## Outcome 2

Bring a dairy herd in for milking.

## Performance criteria

- 2.1 Yard dairy herd in accordance with the supervisor's instructions and without undue stress or injury to cows.
- 2.2 Recognise and report abnormal behaviour or activity of cows at first available opportunity to the supervisor.
- 2.3 Set up gates and fences for the herd for return to pasture according to the supervisor's instructions.
- 2.4 Assess and report paddock conditions, water supply, structures, and stock condition according to the supervisor's instructions.

## Outcome 3

Milk dairy cows.

## Performance criteria

- 3.1 Bail cows quietly and smoothly.
- 3.2 Check cows' udders, quarters, and teats and report unusual condition to the supervisor.
- 3.3 Identify cows whose milk is unsuitable for collection in the herd, and report to the supervisor.
- 3.4 Milk cows hygienically, and completely as directed by the supervisor.

Range cups on, cups off, teat care.

3.5 Carry out teat care as directed by the supervisor.

## Outcome 4

Hose down the farm dairy and yards.

## Performance criteria

- 4.1 Hose farm dairy and yards safely, without risk of injury to staff and animals, or damage to equipment, or facilities.
- 4.2 Set up farm dairy and yards for next milking.
